



Downeaster Thunder Farm Beluga Whale

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fin
cut 2
white or pale gray



This Beluga Whale is super easy. Create two mirror images of the whale for a double-sided ornament. Note: I used two strands of floss throughout. While my whale is a pale blue - white, off-white, or the palest of gray would be more life-like!

Create the eye with a black French knot, or black seed bead. Sew the mouth with a gray or black running stitch. Add the decorative stitching for the neck and tail in a matching color floss.

Position the fin and tack along the top with blanket stitch in matching floss. Pin the two body pieces together; sew together with a blanket stitch using matching floss. Pause before finishing to lightly stuff with fiberfill.
