

Downeast Thunder Farm Christmas Stocking

The perfect perch for your favorite
bird at Christmastime.

Cut two stocking pieces from felt
in your choice of color. Cut out the
branch and moon. Sew on the
branch and moon with a blanket
stitch using matching floss.

Create your favorite bird - the front
side only. Position the bird on the
perch and sew with a blanket
stitch; lightly stuff with fiberfill
before finishing.

Embellish as you like. I added pine needles to my
branch with green floss. On the top of the stocking
front, begin a blanket stitch at the top right, sewing
left across the top on just the front. Fold the tab in
half, pin the the back of the stocking front and catch
it with the blanket stitch. Lay the stocking front on
the back and finish the blanket stitch around the
sides and bottom of the stocking.

Note: for the stocking I used the full thickness of the
embroidery floss through out (six strands).
