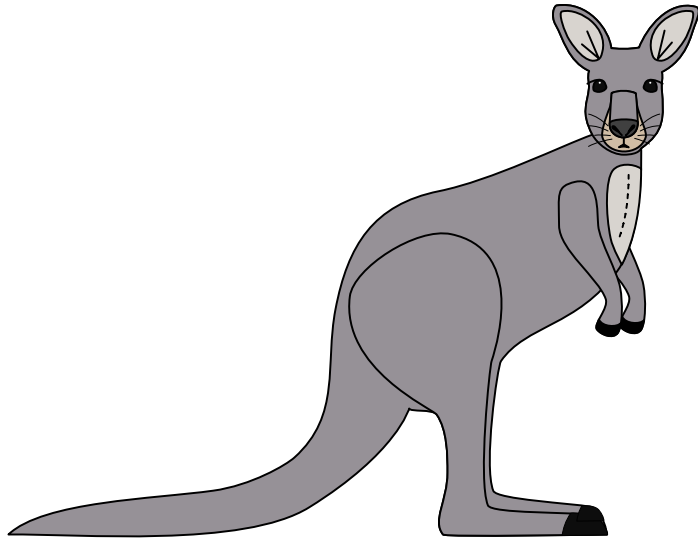


# Downeast Thunder Farm Kangaroo

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Position the leg and sew with a running stitch along the edges with matching floss. Tack on the feet with black floss. Position the arm and attach it with a running stitch around the edges. Add the black for the hands with a satin stitch with black floss. Tack the chest along the edges with tiny white stitches with one strand of white floss. Add a gray running stitch down the center.

Position the lower snout on the face; top with the snout and tack with gray floss. Position the nose and tack with black floss. Add two small gray lazy daisy stitches for the nostrils. Position the ears and tack with tiny white stitches around the edge. Add the gray stitches as illustrated in the pattern. Position the head on the body front. Create eyes with black seed beads or black French knots, add a black stitch for the eyes. With black floss, create the stitches for the mouth.

Add the leg and arm to the body back. Using two strands of matching gray floss (white along the chest), sew the two sides together with a blanket stitch. Before you finish the blanket stitch, pause to lightly stuff the body with fiberfill.
