

# Downeast Thunder Farm Song Sparrow

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For a double-sided ornament, create two mirror images of this pattern. Position the wing on the body. Tack in a few places with matching floss. Position the face and sew a gray running stitch around the outside. Position the beak and tack with dark gray floss. Position the eye and tack.

Position the wing and tack with a running stitch around the edges using matching floss. Position the wing cap and tack with a running stitch around the edges. Using two strands of brown floss add the lazy daisy stitches to the face, body, and wing.

Add the decorative running stitches to the tail and the wing with two strands of dark gray floss.

With two strands of off-white floss, sew a stem stitch to the top of the head as illustrated.

On the back of one of the body pieces, tack on wire for the legs.

Match the two body pieces together and sew the edges together with a blanket stitch. Use matching color floss for each section for the blanket stitch. Pause when 1" before finishing and lightly stuff with fiberfill.
