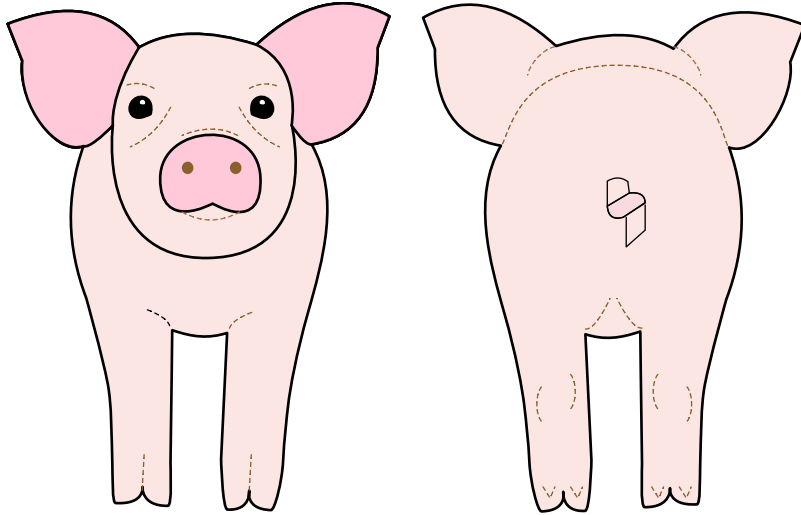
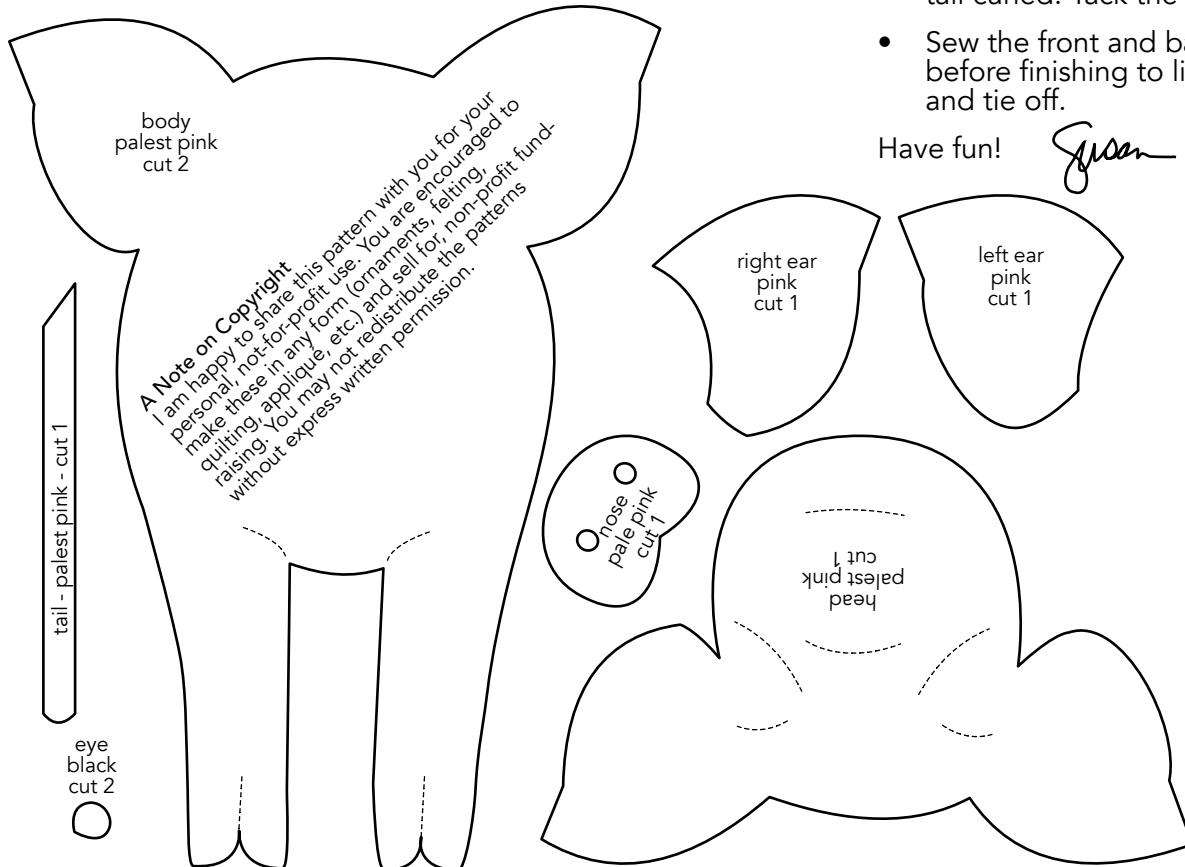


Downeast Thunder Farm Pig

- Position the head on the body and sew the inside edge with a running stitch using pink floss.
- Position the ears and sew the inside edge with a blanket stitch using pink floss.
- Position the nose and sew around the outside with a blanket stitch using pink floss.
- Position the eyes; tack with black floss and finish off with a seed bead.
- Using one strand of medium-brown floss, add the decorative stitching to the face, body, and feet.
- Using two strands of the brown floss, create the nostrils with a satin stitch.
- On the back, using one strand of brown floss, add the decorative stitching.
- Position the top of the tail on the body (point facing down) and tack the top it with pink floss. Take the end of the tail and turn it over, creating a loop to look as if the tail curled. Tack the end of the tail with the pink floss
- Sew the front and back together with a blanket stitch using pink floss. Pause 1.5" before finishing to lightly stuff the body area with fiberfill. Finish the blanket stitch and tie off.
