

Downeast Thunder Farm Barrow's Goldeneye

1. Position the head; pin. Position the face and tack using white floss.
2. Position the eye and tack with a black seed bead or black French knot.
3. With black floss, sew the curve that defines the beginning of the beak with a running stitch. Use a gray running stitch to define the mouth as illustrated.
4. Position the tail and tack the inside edge with gray floss. Use black floss for the decorative stitches.
5. Position the wing and tack along the inside edge with black floss. With white floss, tack the wing markings in place. Add the lazy daisy stitches to the wing using three strands of white floss.
6. Repeat on the mirror side of the second body.
7. Sew the two body parts together with a blanket stitch using two strands of black floss. If desired, pause before finishing to lightly stuff with fiberfill.
