

Downeast Thunder Farm Christmas Tree

- Position the lower bough on the tree base and sew with a running stitch along the inside edges. I used white to mimic snow, but you could choose green floss.
- Repeat with the upper bough.
- Tack the trunk to the back of the tree, being careful to hide the stitches on the front.
- Add seed beads for decorations. I used 6/0 red glass seed beads.
- Create the back in the mirror image in the same manner without the trunk.
- Sew the two trees together. I opted for a white running stitch to mimic snow, but you could use green floss and a blanket stitch. Pause 1.5" from the end and stuff lightly with fiberfill. Finish and tie off.
- Position a star on either side of the tree. Using matching colored floss, tack the star to the tree with a running stitch around the edges.
