


Downeast Thunder Farm Ladybug

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- Note: I used a hole punch to cut out the circles.
- Position the wings on the body. Using one strand of black floss, sew a running stitch that bisects the wings as illustrated.
- Tack the circles with a black running stitch around the edge.
- With three strands of white floss, use a satin stitch to create the triangles at the top of the wings.
- Create the eyes with a trio of white French knots.
- Cut lengths of wire for the legs. Create a loop in the center by wrapping the wire around the needle. Use this loop to tack the three lengths of wire to the back of the body.
- Pin the bodies together. Using two strands of floss, sew with a blanket stitch - red along the body and black along the head. Pause before finishing to lightly stuff with fiberfill if desired. Finish off and bend legs into position and trim if necessary.
