

Downeast Thunder Farm Nashville Warbler

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- Tack the tail to the body. Position the wing. Sew a yellow running stitch along the outside edge and add the decorative stitching as shown.
- Position the head and tack the white and black eye pieces. Finish the eye with a clear seed bead. With gray floss, add the stitches on the cheek. With rust-colored floss, add the stitches on the cap.
- Position the beak and tack with a running stitch for the mouth.
- With white floss, add decorative stitches to the belly.
- Repeat the steps to create a mirror image on the other body piece.
- If desired, tack a bit of wire to the back of the body for the legs.
- Sew the body pieces together with a blanket stitch matching the floss to the color of felt. Pause when you're about 1½" from finishing the blanket stitch and lightly stuff with fiberfill; finish sewing the edge and tie it off.
