


Downeast Thunder Farm Gray Catbird

- Use two strands of floss unless otherwise noted.
- Position the tail on the body and sew with a black running stitch along the inside edge.
- Position the cap and sew a black running stitch along the inside edge.
- Position the beak and stitch with a black running stitch for the mouth.
- Position the eye and tack with an "x" using one strand of black floss and finish with a clear seed bead.
- Position the underpants and sew with a brown running stitch along the inside edge.
- Position the wing and sew with a gray running stitch along the inside edge. Add the decorative running stitches with black floss.
- For a double-sided ornament, repeat the previous steps on the remaining body.
- If desired, add wire legs to the back of the body.
- Sew the bodies together using two strands of floss - black along the cap and tail, gray elsewhere. Pause when you are 1.5" from the end and lightly stuff with fiberfill. Finish stitching and tie it off.
