


# Downeast Thunder Farm Dachshund

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Notes: Use one strand of floss unless noted. Change up the colors or add spots to match your doxie!

- Position the head and tack with a running stitch along the sides.
- Position the ears overlapping the head. Tack along the inside edge with a brown running stitch.
- Position the muzzle and sew with a brown running stitch around the edge.
- Position the nose and tack with black floss. Sew the four long stitches to create the whiskers. Sew the backstitch for the mouth using two strands of black floss.
- If using beads, use 8mm black beads for the eyes; otherwise use the felt eyes provided and tack. Using two strands of brown floss, sew the eyebrows.
- Using black floss, sew the running stitches and backstitch that define the legs and tail.
- For the back, add the ears and the decorative stitches that define the legs and tail.
- Sew the bodies together with a blanket stitch using two strands of brown floss. Pause about 1.5" before finishing to stuff with fiberfill lightly. Finish the blanket stitch and tie off.
- If desired, cut a length of felt and give him a dapper scarf!
