

Downeast Thunder Farm Winter Snowman

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Notes: Use one strand of floss unless noted.

- Cut out the pattern pieces. Pin the patterns to the appropriate felt and cut out the parts. The pattern tells you how many of each part you will need.
- Position the scarf neckband; tuck the scarf tail beneath and fold it over the neckband. Tack with a running stitch along the neckband's edges.
- Sew the gray running stitch that defines the belly.
- Position the hat band and tack with a gray running stitch along the edges. Position the holly and tack with red French knots for the berries.
- Position the nose and tack with a running stitch down the center. Use seed beads or French knots for the eyes. Sew the mouth with a red backstitch. To add rosy cheeks, dab on a bit of blush with a cotton swab.
- Create the buttons with two large black beads or cut circles of black felt.
- Arrange the hat on the head and tack it with a running stitch along the bottom edge.
- To create the back, repeat the neckband, the belly line, and the hat without the holly and berries, making sure you line up the hat to match the front.
- Use twigs or wire for the arms. Tack to the back of a body.
- Pin the two bodies together. Sew the body pieces with a blanket stitch using two strands of white floss. Pause when you're about 1½" from finishing the blanket stitch. Take small amounts of the fiberfill and gently stuff the ornament; finish sewing the edge and tie it off.
